#### **A Few Facts About Our Automotive Academies**

- Park Vista is in its 14<sup>th</sup> year of operation and has three Choice Academies: Automotive Collision and Refinishing, Automotive Service Technology, and Medical Science. Students travel from as far as Boca to be a part of these programs. We also have a Multimedia Communications Academy, an in-house option, for students who attend Park Vista.
- Our student population is approximately 3,050 and over 250 students are in one or both of our two automotive academies.
- Our Automotive Service Technology program continues to maintain NATEF certification.
- Students are in the ninth year of our restoration project of a 1967 Ford Mustang.
- In the past, students have been involved in alternative fuel research such as converting a diesel car to run on Vegetable Oil. This project, nicknamed the "Vegginator", was reported by the Palm Beach Post and News Channel 5.
- We work to prepare all of our students to go on to post-secondary school and many get certified in different areas of ASE before graduation so they can go straight to work.
- Former students are working in the industry such as military transportation units, Delray Motors, Arrigo Dodge, West Palm Kia, Lexus of Palm Beach, Toyota in Broward County and other locations.
