

2011-2012 School Year

We **require** all students to provide proof of residency to register or attend Park Vista High School. We require 3 proofs (1) a current driver’s license, (2) a current lease showing payments or property tax bill (3) a current utility bill, etc. These **must** be provided prior to your child being scheduled here at Park Vista. Your child must be in attendance at registration.

A document from each column must be provided

NOTE: Post Office boxes do not meet residency requirements. Only street addresses are accepted. All proofs submitted must show the residential Palm Beach County address. **Florida Statutes 837.06 provides that whoever knowingly makes a false statement in writing with the intent to mislead a public servant in the performance of his or her official duty shall be guilty of a misdemeanor of the second degree.**
