

Flood zones are determined by the United States Army Corps of Engineers. In Palm Beach, flood zones are scattered across the county and there are no natural dividers that allow us to categorize by geographic area. For example, Boca Raton High School and Boca Raton Middle School are both located east of I-95 and less than a mile apart (North-South), but only the high school is in a flood zone. Further, flood zones are not limited to the east side of our county. For example, West Boca High School is also in a flood zone. Schools located within a flood zone are required to be covered by National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP).
