

On April 13, 2013, Board Member Chuck Shaw asked the following question regarding Board Meeting 4/17/2013 Agenda Item: PR-2 Delray Full Service Center/Toussaint L'Overture Charter School - Second Amendment to Lease. A response is provided below.

Question:

Are they expected to have a site after 2014?

Response:

Toussaint L'Overture High School first requested the use of space at the Delray Full Service Center on an emergency basis due to the loss of their lease in 2011. Given that this is the second extension, it does not look promising that a site will be secured by 2014. In fact, their letter dated February 28, 2013 (Exhibit "C"), Toussaint requested the continued use of the space at the Delray Full Service Center through June 2016, which is the end date of their charter agreement.

Question:

If it is likely they will not, would consider the term to go maybe 3 years in order not to bring this back annually?

If so, we could entertain cancellation if they do find a site and not have to do yearly agreements?

THOUGHTS???

Response:

The staff recommended a single year extension because we have been looking at other District plans for the facility and this is was not intended to be a long-term location for the Charter.

If the Board so desires, the term of the agreement could be increased to three (3) years, subject to a cancellation provision if Toussaint locates a more permanent location or if the School Board needs the space for other District programs.
